DEFERRAL POLICY

Request for deferred participation in an American Councils Study Abroad program must be submitted in writing. In their written notification, students must indicate in which future program term they intend to participate within the next 12 months. Requests to defer will only be considered after the non-refundable deposit is received by American Councils.

Students who receive approval to defer will have their deposit applied towards a future program term within the next 12 months.

Students who do not participate in their American Councils Study Abroad program within a 12-month period from their original application will not be refunded the non-refundable program deposit and will need to reapply to the program in order to participate in a future term beyond the 12-month period.

In the case of deferral by an American Councils financial aid recipient, all scholarships received must be returned to American Councils within 14 days of the deferral notification. Financial aid awards cannot be deferred. Students deferring to a new term must reapply for financial aid.
